Assumption of Risk and Waiver of Liability 1.

Assumption of Risk

- The undersigned is aware of the inherent Risks of injury, death and property damage to the undersigned, to his or her dog(s) that are involved in the recreational activity of canine agility, including without limitations, risks due to dog bite, the use of agility equipment, or infectious disease. The undersigned is aware of the risks of injury, death and property damage that may result from, among other causes, the active or passive negligence of WAG, INC. and the Border Collie Club of Northern California. The undersigned is voluntarily engaging in dog agility as a recreational activity with the knowledge of the risks of injury, death and property damage that may result from participation in dog agility. **Release of Liability**
- The undersigned releases WAG, Inc. and the Border Collie Club of Northern California from all liability to the "undersigned" representatives, guardians, successors, assigns, heirs, and next of kin for all liability, claims, damage, or demands for personal injury, death, or property damage to the undersigned or the undersigned's dog or dogs, arising from or related to this agreement. This release includes, without limitation, any personal injury, death, or property damage caused by the active or passive negligence of WAG, Inc. and the Border Collie Club of Northern California. The undersigned bears responsibility for any loss. **Knowing and Voluntary Execution**
 - The undersigned acknowledges that he or she has carefully read this agreement, understands its contents, and understands that this agreement includes an assumption of risk of WAG, Inc. and the Border Collie Club of Northern California's negligence and a release of their liability. The undersigned acknowledges that WAG, Inc. and the Border Collie Club of Northern California are materially relying on this waiver in allowing the undersigned to participate in this dog agility event.
 - I also state that my dog(s) are not aggressive towards people or other dogs and that I understand** that I alone am responsible for the behavior of my dog(s), that any dog, which is out of control, creates an unnecessary disturbance or engages in unsafe or disruptive behavior, may at the discretion of the organizing committee, be expelled from the event grounds with NO REFUNDS.

Directions to WAG, Inc. (Western Agility Group) 10925 Bruceville Road, Elk Grove, CA:

From I-5 to Elk Grove. Take the Elk Grove Blvd. Exit and go East. Turn right on Bruceville Rd. Go approximately 3.5 miles to the driveway on the left. 10925 Bruceville Rd. There will be a sign by the fence and the road is marked "WAG's Teeter Trail". Follow driveway to the rear.

From Hwy 99 to Elk Grove. Take the Elk Grove Blvd. exit and go West. Turn left on Bruceville Rd. Go approximately 3.5 miles to the driveway on the left. 10925 Bruceville Rd. There will be a sign by the fence and the road is marked "WAG's Teeter Trail". Follow driveway to the rear.

Additional Information

This event is not for competition, but is meant for **FUN, experience and practice** to prepare handler and dog for actual trialing. **No judging will occur and no placements, awards, trophies or ribbons will be given.** If you have been through agility classes, but are not quite ready to trial, this is a great opportunity to help prepare you and your dog for competition. We ask that you have at least six full months of weekly training classes and that you participate with the concurrence of your instructor. Runs will be timed and each run will be limited to a maximum of 90 seconds for the standard ring and 75 seconds for the jumpers ring. Treats and toys in the ring are encouraged, and praising your dog is mandatory. Dogs must be able to do all pieces of equipment safely and must be under control both in and out of the ring. Harsh corrections, either physical or verbal, will not be tolerated.

Jump Height and Age: Jump height is at your discretion (we suggest you jump the height you practice in class). **Dogs must be at least ONE year old to participate.**

Advanced Runs: These are for dogs already in competition. You must have earned at least one qualifying run at the novice level before you can run an advanced course.

Dogs cannot run on a leash, and only flat buckle collars (no tags or tabs) are allowed in the ring.

Novice and Advanced dogs will run together. There will be nested courses in both rings with an advanced and a novice course. The handler will choose what course or obstacles they perform.

Confirmations: If entry confirmations are requested they will be sent via e-mail. Please make sure to carefully print your e-mail address and double-check for accuracy or we will not be able to send you a confirmation.

The organizing committee may refuse entry for any reason. There will be no refunds for entries withdrawn after the closing date or in the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from the event, regardless of the reason for dismissal. It is expressly understood that entrants alone are responsible for the behavior of themselves, their dogs, children and guests. Any entrant whose dogs, children, guests or themselves create unnecessary disturbances or engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior, may at the discretion of the organizing committee, may be asked to leave event grounds or remove the offending dogs, children, or guests from the event grounds. No refund of fees will be made in such a case. Gate Steward may excuse team for any infractions with NO REFUNDS.

This event will be limited to entries of 400 runs. We will allow for day of event entries only until that total is reached and not full before the event date. If you decide to enter day of event, be advised that it may be filled before you get there, or may fill while you stand in line. You may verify the status of the event by e-mailing the Event Chair at ewoksemail@comcast.net up until 6:00 p.m. on . March 20th to see if there is still room available for day of event entries or call 916-849-3934. Entries may not be canceled, changed or altered after the closing date.

Check-In will begin at 8:30 a.m., handler briefing will begin at 9:00 p.m. with first walkthroughs to begin immediately thereafter. We will start the first run after the handler briefing.

Set up area under the covered arena is limited, so bring tents or canopies just in case.
